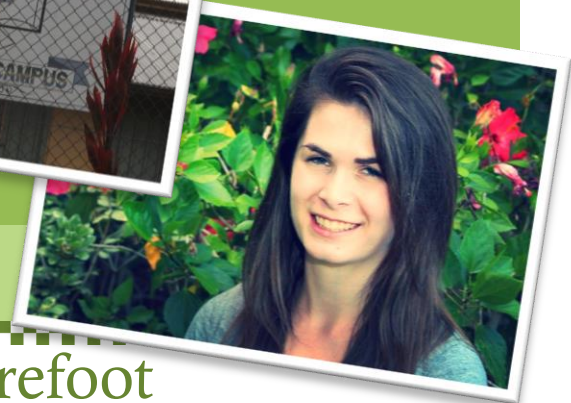

The last four months at school I've had the privilege of teaching and working with people from at least ten different countries. It's an incredibly unique environment.
